Ground School - Sim/Base - Line - Meet the minimum stds of the 'Short Guide' - Demonstrate that they: have the knowledge the necessary instructional skills the ability to evaluate CRM can facilitate a constructive debrief - Role model all aspects of good CRM

Additionally;

Sim/Base

- Hold a TRI, TRE, SFI or SFE authority

Line

- Hold position as an LTC
- Nominated by company, accepted by CAA
- Demonstrate the ability to assess CRM



Accreditation:

Ground School

- Grandfather rights, accredited by 30/9/04
- New, observed by a CRMLE during a course (no later than 31/3/03)

Sim/Base

- Existing TRI/TRE/SFI/SFEs accredited during normal revalidation process by 30/9/04
- New TRI /TRE/SFI/SFEs to be accredited coincident with initial process



Line

- NO grandfather rights
- By observation during a workshop, on a line flight or LOFT
- All accreditations are valid for an initial period of three years (subject to continued employment as a CRMI)

Revalidation:

Ground School

 Conduct > 2 courses each year in 3 year period and one in last year to be observed

Sim/Base

- at the time of revalidating their authority

Line

 On a three yearly revalidation process in a workshop, during an actual line flight or LOFT Civil Avia



Record Keeping:

- Records of all training must be kept for three years
- Details:
 - Date
 - Type of course
 - Name(s) of candidate(s)
 - Type of a/c or sim



General:

- May be qualified in more than one context
- Qualification may be carried forward to another operator subject to appropriate training
- May be an instructor for more than one company at any one time
- All CRMIs should be nominated in the OM (Trg)
- Standardisation will be by opportunity observations by inspectors of the CAA
