Objective: ICAO requires all MROs, operators and regulators to have a Safety Management System (SMS) in place by January 2009. In this conference we aim to look at SMS and in particular the risks to our business that come from human factors in maintenance. Building on our last conference based on investing in safety, we will be discussing risk, intervention strategies and safety culture. As an industry, are we aware of our greatest risks and how do we manage them?

The conference will explore:

- Safety Management Systems – what is the benefit?
- What are the greatest areas of risk to our business?
- A different perspective on risk from other industries.
- The regulatory view.

This conference will be of interest to Accountable Managers, Quality Managers and those engaged in the management of Flight Safety, Maintenance and Planning. It is particularly relevant to those who are involved in implementing or working with their company's SMS.
