

# Measuring safety culture, from a maintenance human factors perspective

BAe Woodford, near Manchester - 26th April 2004 Organized by the Royal Aeronautical Society Human Factors Group, Engineering Maintenance Standing Group (EMSG)

**Objective:** The objective of this conference is to provide industry with some tools which they may be able to use to help them with the either the implementation of human factors programmes, or measuring the effectiveness of such programmes.


